We go out in 2’s or 3’s and generally chat to people, hand out hot chocolate and keep an eye open for the vulnerable. The aim is to keep people safe but as we do this we are bringing Christ’s presence into the situation whether people recognise this or not. Everything has significance to God and everything is part of His world. It is a privilege to serve Jesus Christ in whatever He puts into our hands.”
